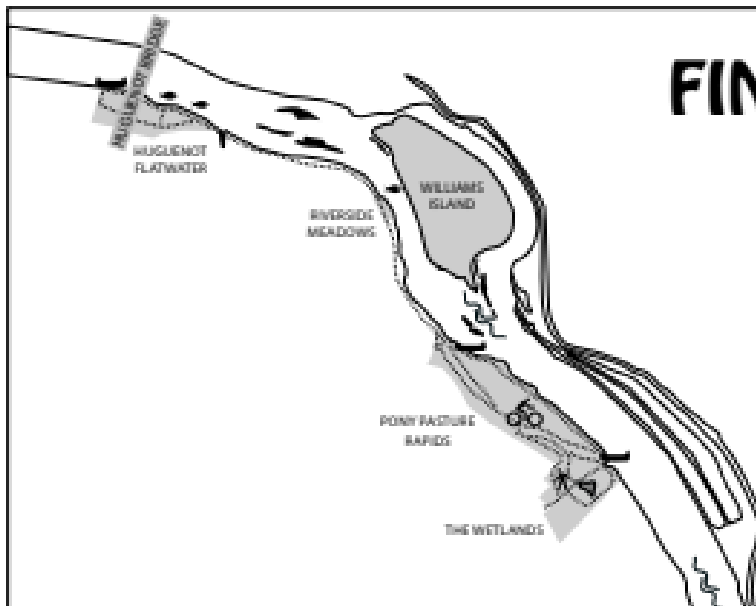


FIND FUN IN JAMES RIVER PARK

4. Circle three places you can go fishing.

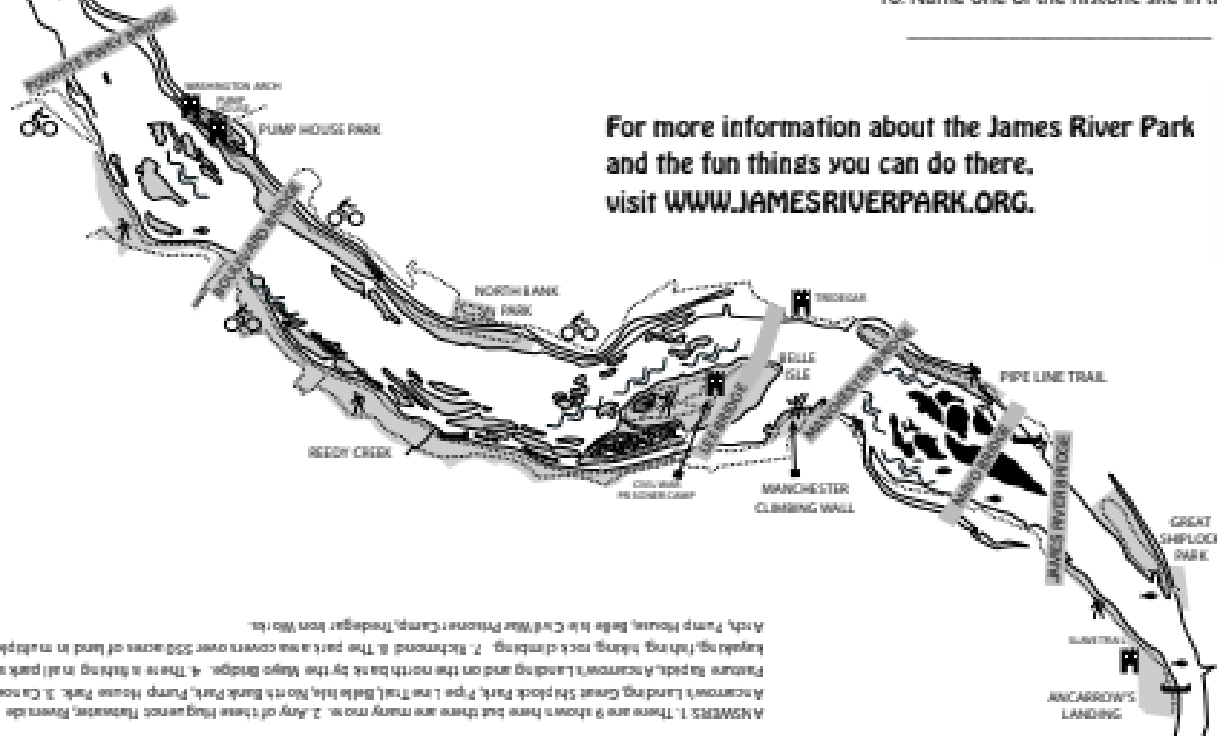
5. What was Belle Isle used for during the Civil War?

Any of these (ing or not) Reservoir, Riverside Meadows, Pony Pasture Meadows, Williams Island, The Wetlands, Reddy Creek, Manchester Climbing Wall, A narrow Landing, Great Shiplock Park, Pipe Line Trail, Belle Isle, North Bank Park, Pump House Park. 3. Canoe/Kayak put in areas are at Reddy Creek, Huguenot Flatwater, The Wetlands, Pony Pasture, a narrow Landing and on the north bank by the Mayo Bridge. 4. There is fishing in all park sections along the river. 5. A prisoner of war camp, 6. Any of these: Pipe Line, canoeing or kayaking, fishing, rock climbing. 7. Richmond. 8. The part area covers over 550 acres of land in a single location. 9. Seven bridges are shown here. 10. Historical areas in the park are Washington Park, Pump House, Belle Isle Civil War Prisoner Camp, Redegar from Mo. etc.
