COLLABORATION HIGHLIGHTS:

PARTNER: GARDEN AT MLK MIDDLE SCHOOL

With support from local after school coordinator NextUP RVA, Fit4Kids collaborated with nonprofit and community partners, including Storefront for Community Design and Kinfolk/Community Unity in Action, to lead a STEM-based afterschool garden club at MLK Middle School in Richmond. This partnership is an example of a community garden on school grounds where student input actually informed and influenced the layout and design of the garden. We're eager to replicate similar collaborations in the next couple of years!

DISTRICT: HOPEWELL PUBLIC SCHOOLS

This marked Fit4Kids seventh year of collaborating with Hopewell Public Schools in partnership with the John Randolph Foundation! This collaboration reached 1,753 students last school year through school gardens and Wellness Integration at all three Hopewell Elementary Schools. With seven years of experience and training under their belts, schools in Hopewell will be moving into a sustainability model as our Wellness Integration Specialist begins programming in Prince George.

INITIATIVE: MAKING THE MOST OF RECESS

While some schools are eliminating recess due to academic pressures and inadequate facilities, Fit4Kids believes this time promotes students' social, physical, and emotional health. We partner with schools to ensure fun, physically-active, and meaningful play opportunities during recess.

RECENT HIGHLIGHTS:

- Teaming up with Petersburg Public Schools to raise funds to build a new playground at Pleasants Lane Elementary, which had been without one for years.
- Partnered with Sports Backers and Richmond Public Schools PE Department to raise funds for recess and PE equipment for Fox Elementary School after their devastating fire.
- Supported Henry Marsh Elementary in Richmond with teacher training and recess kits. We'll continue to provide dozens of schools with training and equipment this school year!
